Cost
Bottled water costs between \$0.89 a gallon to \$8.26 a gallon, compared to pennies a gallon.

Environmental Impact
Only 20% of the 1 trillion bottles produced last year were recycled.

The average plastic bottle takes 650 years to break down in a landfill.
