## **Toilets**

If your toilet is continually draining and refilling, the plunger ball or flapper valve probably needs replacing. If the water flow doesn't stop after flushing, you may have to adjust or replace the float ball.





If the faucet keeps dripping even when tightly closed, the problem is most likely a worn or improperly fitted washer. Washerless faucets may need to be rebuilt or replaced.



## **Refrigerators** Small puddles under the

refrigerator and excessive ice accumulation in the freezer may mean the ice-making unit isn't working properly.





## **Hot water tanks**

Water dripping down the side of the tank and accumulating on the floor below is often a sign that the pressure valve release isn't working properly.

## **Dishwashers**

Water on the floor around the unit? Probably a leak.

If outdoor faucets haven't been drained and closed tightly, winter temperatures can cause them to freeze. Check for leaks when the
