ADVICE LETTER NO. 1450

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

California-American Water Company ("California American Water") (U210W) submits this advice letter for review. The advice letter includes the attached tariff sheets, which apply to California American Water's acquisition of the Bass Lake Water Company ("Bass Lake").

Purpose:

This advice letter requests Commission approval to create the Bass Lake Transaction Memorandum Account ("BLTMA").

Background:

California American Water filed Application ("A.") 22-03-002 requesting approval of the sale of Bass Lake's assets to California American Water on March 1, 2022. On April 6, 2023, the Commission approved the asset sale in Decision ("D.") 23-04-007.

The requests contained in this advice letter relate to Ordering Paragraph ("OP") 7 of D. 23-04-007, which states:

7. California-American Water Company is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter to establish a Bass Lake Transaction Memorandum Account consistent with this decision.

The decision also states, "Cal-Am is authorized to establish the Bass Lake Transaction Cost Memorandum Account (BLTCMA) with an effective date of March 1, 2022, which is the date the joint Application was filed."¹ Based on the foregoing OP and language from the decision, California American Water submits the following requests to create the BLTMA.

Request:

In accordance with OP 7 of D. 23-04-007, California American Water requests authorization to establish the BLTMA.

Tier Designation:

This advice letter is submitted pursuant to General Order No. 96-B and is designated as a Tier 1 filing.

Effective Date:

California American Water requests an effective date of March 1, 2022.

Notice and Service List:

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rule 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be transmitted electronically to interested parties having

Response or Protest²

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. When submitting a response or protest, please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds³ are:

- 1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- 2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- 3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- 4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- 5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- 6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

BX. Bass Lake Transaction Memorandum Account (BLTMA)

1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of the BLTMA is to record and track transactional costs associated with the purchase of Bass Lake Water Company. Examples of such costs include but are not limited to expenses for: outside legal services, engineering, surveying, the appraisal, customer noticing, and other professional activities necessary to complete the transaction. Decision 23-04-007 granted California American Water authority to establish the BLTMA.

2. APPLICABILITY:

California American Water's Bass Lake Service Area in Madera County.

3. ACCOUNTING PROCEDURE:

California-American Water shall maintain the BLTMA by making entries at the end of each month as follows:

- a. A debit entry will be created to capture transaction costs associated with the acquisition of Bass Lake Water Company.
- b. A debit or credit entry equal to interest on the balance in the account at the beginning of the month and half the balance after the above entries, at a rate equal to one-twelfth of the rate on 90 day non-financial Commercial Paper, as reported in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15 or it successor.
- c. A credit entry will be made to transfer the balances to the appropriate district Consolidated Expense Balancing Account's (CEBA) upon Commission approval.

4. RATEMAKING PROCEDURE:

The memorandum account currently has no rate component.

5. **DISPOSITION:**

Disposition of amounts recorded in the BLTMA shall be determined through a Tier 3 advice letter filing or in California American Water's next General Rate Case application or as otherwise determined by the Commission. Upon Commission review and approval, balances shall be transferred to the appropriate district's CEBA for recovery/refund.
