**Affordability Rate for first 1,500 gallons:** As part of Indiana American Water's 2024 rate case, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved a new affordability rate for residential water customers with a 5/8" meter. Specifically, customers who use up to 1,500 gallons per month would pay a flat fee of \$20, with no additional volumetric charges for that usage.
